

State and Territory Representatives

Role

- Act as a conduit for information about ACEA to all personnel involved in offender education and vocational education and training in correctional settings.
- Promote ACEA membership within corrective services and educational institutions and other stakeholders in the state.
- Promote participation of State individuals and organisations at the biennial conference.

Responsibilities

- co-ordinate, promote and gather newsletter articles for ACEA on education, vocational education and training in correctional settings;
- monitor state membership and advise members of renewals;
- provide feedback to executive on any issues pertaining to the organisation;
- convey the needs identified by state members to the ACEA Executive;
- contact state universities and enquire about research being conducted relevant to correctional settings. Forward this information to the Research Officer and the ACEA Executive;
