Nominations/Voting – ACEA Office bearers

To ensure that all **financial** members have the opportunity to be nominated for positions, the ACEA is inviting eligible **financial** members to be nominated for positions prior to the Annual General Meeting. Nomination forms for the positions can be found on the ACEA website. Please refer to the website: www.acea.org.au for roles and responsibilities for the positions. If you are interested in being nominated for any of the positions you will need to be **financial** and be nominated and seconded by a **financial** ACEA member. Nominations will need to be received by COB on **4th October 2019**.

Once nominations have been received, all financial members attending the ACEA AGM will then be invited to vote for candidates of their choice.

Please note:

1. All **financial** members are eligible to vote for all office bearer positions.
2. For the **State/Territory/Indigenous/New Zealand Representative** positions only financial members from the various States/Territory/New Zealand are eligible to vote for people nominated for that particular State/Territory.
3. **Voting will take place at the ACEA AGM at the RACV Club on Tuesday 15th October at 7.30 am.**

In summary:

- Nominations are called for all ACEA office bearer positions and State/Territory/Indigenous/New Zealand positions and will need to be received by COB, **4th October 2019** by PDF attachment to an email.

- On **Tuesday 15th October 2019**, all financial members of ACEA present at the AGM will be invited to vote for the nominated people.
- All voting will be by secret ballot and votes will be counted, and the positions announced at the ACEA AGM and posted on the ACEA website.
- Counting of votes will be conducted by two independent scrutineers

The intention of this process is to give all financial members present at the ACEA the opportunity to cast a vote.
